Policy & Procedure

The Library Media Center opens at 8:00AM when school is in session. Students are welcome to use all the resources in the media center.

- Any student coming to the library during the school day must have a written pass from their teacher.
- Everyone must sign in when entering the library.
- All students must be in dress code and wearing their school ID
- The Authorized User Policy distributed by the Board of Education is posted and must be adhered to when using computers.
- Absolutely no food or drink is allowed in the media center.
- Please do not check out a book for another student.
- Students are expected to pay in full for any lost or damaged materials.

Resources

Books - Patrons are permitted to check out books for 2 weeks renewable if no other student has requested the book.

Limit - 2 books per student for class projects

Periodicals - 3 daily newspapers and 64 magazines which may be checked out.

Audio-Visual Material - Includes video tapes, DVD's, audiotapes, computer software. This material may be borrowed by teachers for 5 days but used by students only in the media center.

Equipment - Arrangements to borrow equipment (TV's, digital cameras, digital video cameras, LCD projectors) must be made at least 24 hours in advance to ensure that equipment is available and charged. Patrons must supply their own disks and tapes.

Reserve Material - Teachers may place materials on reserve for use only by their students within the library for class projects.

Computer Software—Computer software is to be used in the Media Center. Teachers may sign it out for classroom use for a period of 7 days.

School ID's are your library card and must be presented when circulating material.

Copy Machine Usage

There is a copy machine in the Media Center for student use. The charge is .05 a copy. Please limit to school related projects.
