

Our Adult High School Diploma Program

If you are over 18 years of age, and have not been in a traditional high school for at least one year, this program is for you!

Our Adult High School Diploma Program will help you meet the requirements needed to earn a high school diploma. This includes: earning the equivalent of 110 credits; and preparing for and passing the New Jersey State-required High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) test, which demonstrates your command of reading, writing and mathematics.

Our knowledgeable staff will work with you to properly document credits for previous studies and skills learned outside the classroom. Credits may be awarded based upon the following:

- Transcript from an accredited high school, or vocational school that shows credits already earned;
- Work experience;
- Military experience;
- Examination (up to 5 credits for each exam taken).

Classes begin each fall, winter and spring. (Please call 201-915-6210 for registration dates.) ***You must bring the following documents with you when you register:***

- All previous high school transcripts, including any HSPA test scores
- Valid photo identification
- Proof of Jersey City residency
- Social security card
